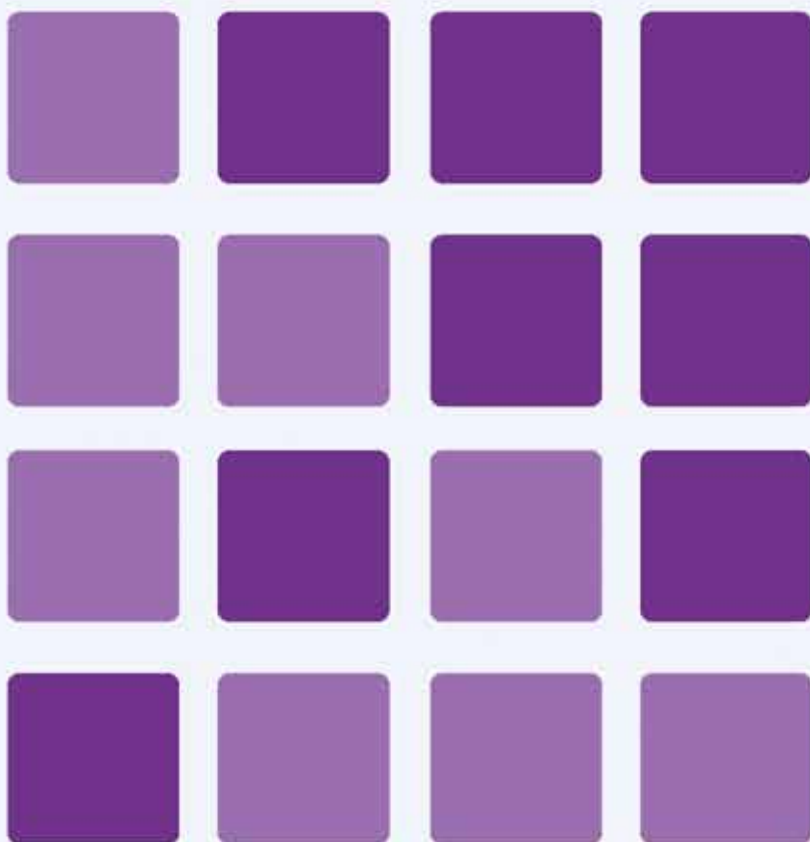

Since 1993 Cavotec Middle East (CME), the UAE based subsidiary of Cavotec MSL, has developed a great number of important references within the Region. CME has supplied Dubai airport with 400 Hz cable coils, power caddies, pop-up and hatch pits, refueling systems (fuel hydrant pits & valves, loading arms) and Wibe cable management system. Cavotec equipment is installed in the airports of Sharjah, Abu Dhabi, Ras al Khaimah, Jordan, Qatar, KSA, Oman, Kuwait and Iran.

In December 2009 Cavotec's Airport Market Unit was awarded with a landmark order in Bahrain where our airport systems were selected to supply and integrate a range of environmentally friendly ground service equipment for remote aircraft aprons at Bahrain International Airport.

The product and technological scope of this particular order is especially broad. With 18 of Cavotec's pre-conditioned air (PCAir) systems, forming the centerpiece of the project, Cavotec will also deliver and install pop-up units, transformer sub-stations, 400Hz power supply systems, a Vacuum Evacuation System, a blue water supply system and a potable water supply system.

More recently, Cavotec received a large order to install 53 advanced fuel hydrant systems and related material at Mumbai's Chhatrapati Shivaji International Airport (CSIA) as part of the airport's modernization programme.

Cavotec ME has launched a new gate concept that presents significant improvements in energy efficiency, fuel cost savings, decrease usage of auxiliary power units (APU) and reductions in carbon footprint within airport operations across the region. This concept promises operational efficiency by allowing the provision of up to six aircraft ground services (400Hz - PCAir - Blue Water - Potable Water - Sewage - Air Start) through the firm's proprietary underground Pop Up pits. The innovative process eliminates the need for ground support equipment (GSE) mobile vehicles, translating to a lower risk of accidents and lower maintenance and repair costs of support vehicles. The solution will address cost reduction via a multipronged approach, which will give airlines and airport authorities the opportunity to save millions of dollars every year.

AL AIN INTERNATIONAL AVIATION ACADEMY



The Al Ain International Aviation Academy in the United Arab Emirates opened its doors in 2009, with the goal of providing comprehensive aeronautics-related education and training leading to nationally and internationally recognised qualifications. The Academy is part of the Institute of Applied Technology (IAT) organisation.

The Academy's principle focus is to develop programmes in aircraft maintenance technologies. Students are currently all Emirati nationals. The programmes are approved by the UAE General Civil Aviation Authority, the UAE Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, and the European Aviation Safety Agency (EASA). The Academy offers programmes that cover the EASA Part 66 curriculum, and lead to a Higher Diploma in either Aircraft Maintenance or Aircraft Engineering

Technologies. Students have the opportunity, upon graduation, to continue their studies in the United Kingdom toward a Bachelor of Engineering Honours degree in Aircraft Engineering at Kingston University.

Customer organisations of the Academy fall into two groups. The first category includes organisations engaged in the business of aircraft maintenance. These include Abu Dhabi Aircraft Technologies (ADAT) and the UAE Armed Forces (GHQ). Secondly, the Academy is building a network of academic partners. In 2010 Mubadala Aerospace selected the Academy to provide training support for aerospace activities it intends to establish in Al Ain. The first of these initiatives is Strata Manufacturing, for which the Academy is supplying a series of training programmes in composite materials.

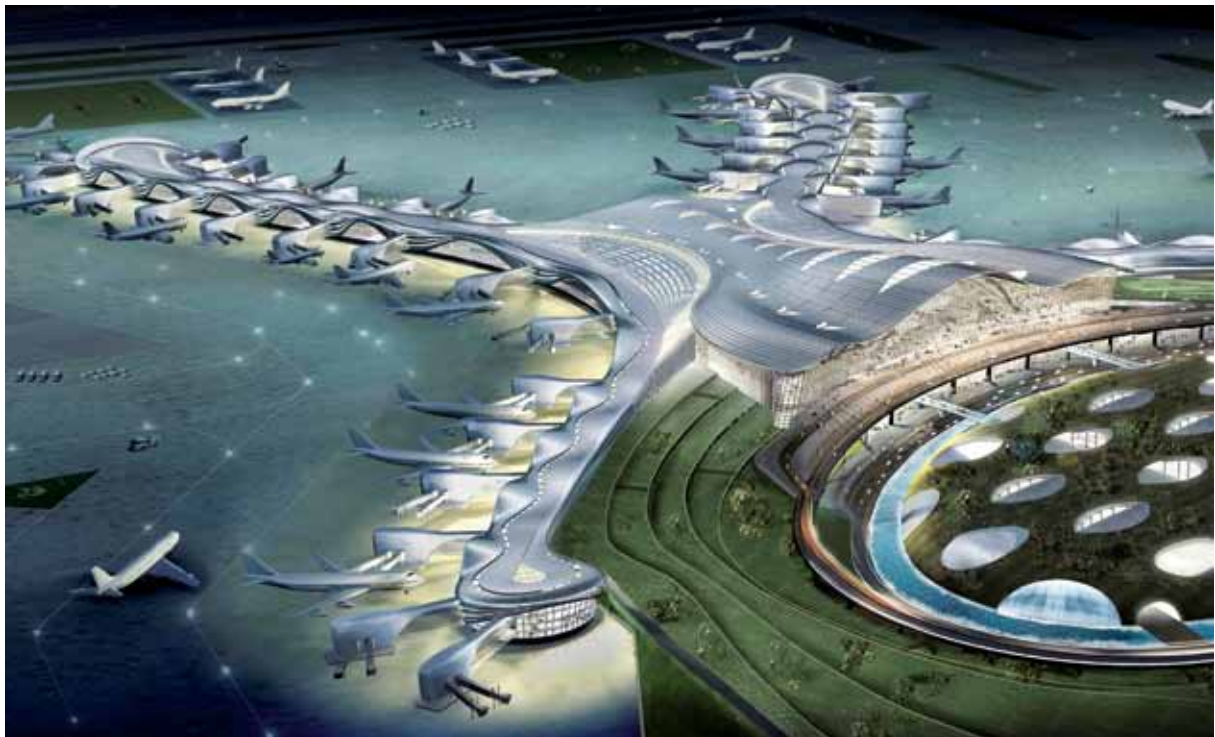

ABU DHABI AIRPORTS COMPANY



Abu Dhabi Airports Company (ADAC) is a public joint-stock company wholly owned by the Abu Dhabi Government. It was incorporated by Amiri Decree number 5, issued on 4 March 2006, to spearhead the development of the Emirate's aviation infrastructure.

In September 2006, ADAC took over responsibility for the operation and management of Abu Dhabi and Al Ain international Airports. In 2008, ADAC added Al Bateen private jet airport, formerly Al Bateen military airbase, and Sir Bani Yas and Delma Island Airports to its portfolio.

These airports all serve different segments of the

marketplace and help contribute to Abu Dhabi's development as a destination for both business and leisure tourism.

Currently under way is the large scale AED25 (US\$6.8) billion re-development and expansion of Abu Dhabi International Airport designed to increase the overall capacity of the airport to more than 20 million passengers per year.

As part of this redevelopment, a second runway and a third terminal have been completed. A new ATC tower and Midfield Terminal Complex will complete the redevelopment within the next few years.

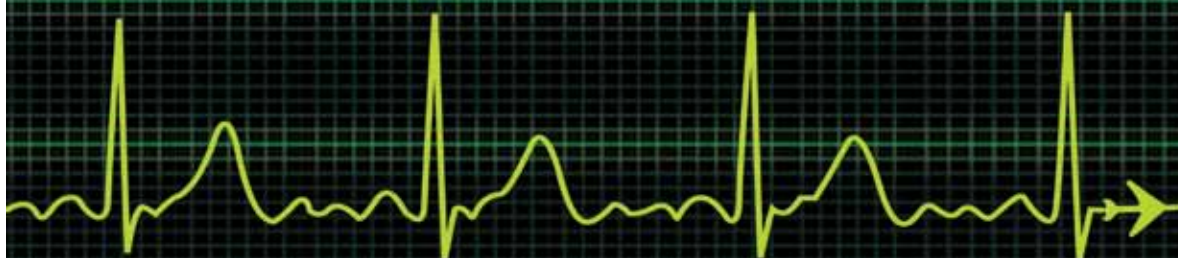

Dubai International: 50 years of growth and vision

Dubai Airports owns and manages the operation and development of both of Dubai's airports – Dubai International as well as the recently opened Dubai World Central – Al Maktoum International.

Dubai International

Dubai International is the fastest growing airport for international passengers among the top 50 airports on Airports Council International's list, recording a growth rate of 9.2 per cent and 40.9 million passengers in 2009. Dubai International is connected to over 220 destinations across six continents through 130 scheduled airlines.

Dubai International currently has an annual capacity of 60 million passengers, a figure that will increase to 75 million on completion of Concourse 3, the world's first A380-dedicated facility.

Dubai World Central – Al Maktoum International

Dubai's airport of the future is at the heart of a major airport-city project just 40 kilometres away from Dubai International. The first phase of the project opened for

cargo operations on June 27, 2010 while passenger operations are currently slated to start up next year in concert with the IATA schedule change.

Phase 1 of the airport features one A380 capable runway, 64 remote stands, one cargo terminal with annual capacity for 250,000 tonnes of cargo and a passenger terminal building designed to accommodate five million passengers per year.

Dubai World Central – Al Maktoum International will increase Dubai's airport capacity to accommodate the 48 per cent increase in cargo volumes from 1.9 to 3 million tonnes that is anticipated by 2015. In the long term it will serve as a multi-modal logistics hub for 12 million tonnes of freight and a global gateway for the 150 million passengers per annum that are expected to pass through Dubai by 2030.

Dubai Airports delivers a world-class experience for customers by providing safe, secure and environmentally responsible airports. Dubai Airports works in partnership with airlines, passengers and employees to drive the growth of Dubai as the world's emerging centre for leisure and business.
